

# Spelling Pattern: "in"

The letters "in" form both a word and a spelling pattern. Words with this pattern often rhyme.

Words	In Context
in	I got <b>in</b> the car.
win	He will <b>win</b> this game.
fin	The fish has one <b>fin</b> on each side.
pin	Do not drop that <b>pin</b> .
tin	She put the water in a <b>tin</b> cup.
thin	They need food. They look too <b>thin</b> .
skin	He had dark <b>skin</b> .
chin	She hit her <b>chin</b> on the ground.
grin	I gave them a big <b>grin</b> .
begin	We saw the truck <b>begin</b> to move.

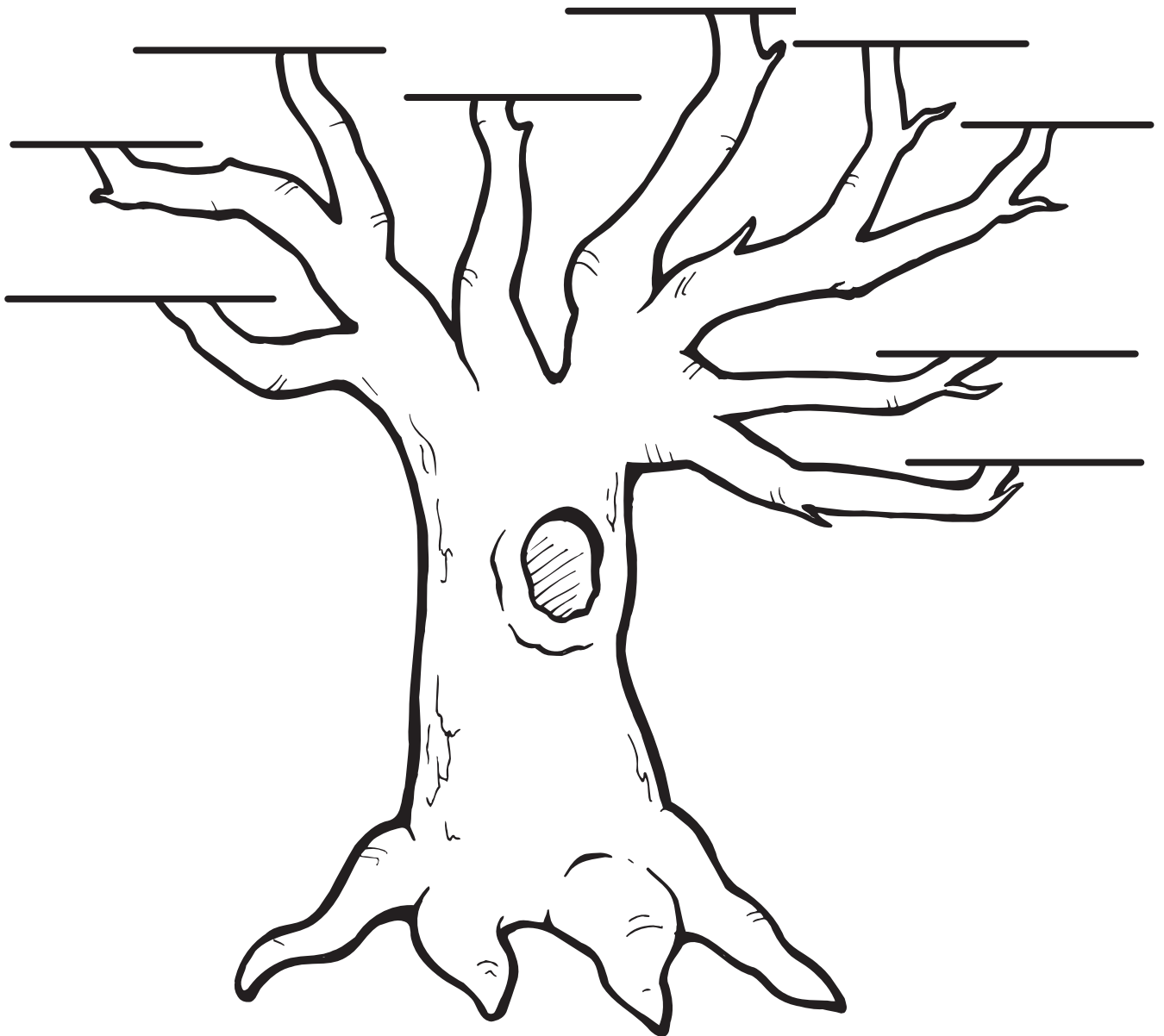
