

# Introduction

This *Word Book* is an important reference for students because it lists over 1,000 of the most common words in the English language (the famous Instant Words plus a few more) in alphabetical order. Since these words make up over 90% of all written material, beginning writers can quickly find how to spell them. To make it easier for students, words are grouped by the first two letters in each word.

Blank pages are provided, too, so students can add their own words. Students will want to add words that were misspelled on writing assignments or spelling tests, words that refer to a particular subject of interest, words that they frequently ask others how to spell, and words related to the type of material to which they have been exposed. By adding their own words, students will find this *Word Book* to be a valuable reference guide that they will use over and over again.

There is also helpful information at the back of the *Word Book*, which can aid students in becoming more skillful writers.

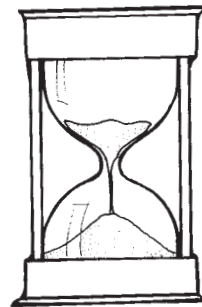

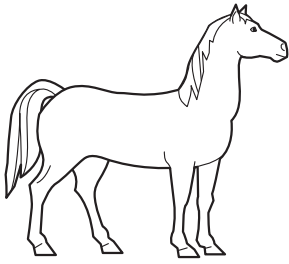
