**Title/Skill:** From Liquid to Gas  
**Grade:** 4 **Subject:** Science  
**Topic:** States of Matter **Unit:** 2

**Summary:**  
 Students observe the changes in the physical states of matter using water as an example.

**Objectives:**  
 Students will observe how water (liquid state) changes into vapor (gaseous state) in the presence of heat.

**Procedures:**  
 Materials: hot plate; dark food coloring; 1-ounce (30 mL) cups filled with water; heat-proof clear glass container; large candy thermometer; permanent black marker; What Happened to the Water? Data Sheet
