One important symbol of America is the flag. When people see the flag, they sometimes think of the pledge. The pledge is an important American oath.

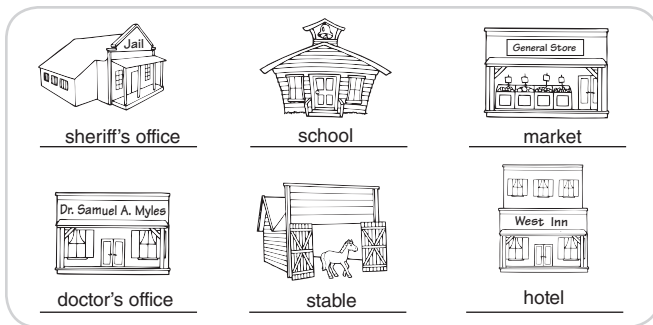
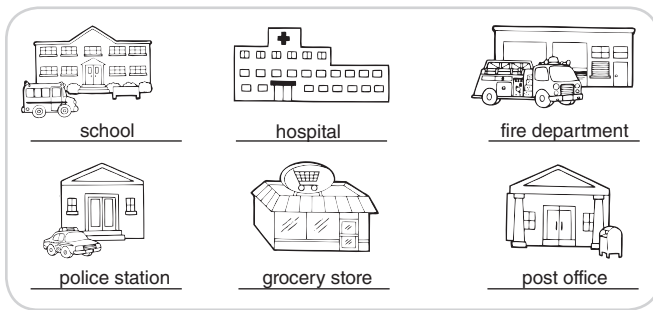

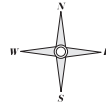
